LA Art Show, now in its 20th year, continues to bring together some of the world's leading galleries working in traditional and contemporary art.

ver the past 20 years, LA Art Show has provided collectors one stop for traditional and contemporary artwork by emerging through master artists. Each year, galleries from around the world gather for the fair, with the event only consistently growing and expanding. At the 2014 edition alone, more than 50,000 art patrons attended and galleries reported sales into the millions.

LA Art Show, which takes place at the Los Angeles Convention Center, is highlighted by not only the galleries and artwork on display, but also special exhibits, guided show tours, mixers and a lecture series with discussions from industry experts. To kick off the fair every year is the star-studded Opening Night Premiere Party, on January 14 from 8 to 11 p.m. Past attendees have included Barbra Streisand, James Brolin, Leonardo DiCaprio, Henry Winkler, Jerry Bruckheimer, Lily Collins, Shepard Fairey, and many others.

"Alexi is America's most innovative up-and-coming contemporary Cuban artist with several one-man museum exhibitions behind him and many planned on his calendar for the future," says Evan Lurie, owner of the gallery. "The gallery is proud to represent this rising star at a very important time in his career."
